



Timberlake INSTALLATION GUIDE

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU BEGIN INSTALLATION. IMPROPER INSTALLATION WILL VOID WARRANTY.



ALWAYS WORK FROM A MINIMUM OF 3 CARTONS

Basic rules before installation:

- Please store flat panels in the unopened package for at least 72 hours (min. 65°F (18°C))
- Panels must be checked for defects under suitable lighting conditions
- Complaints concerning used panels will not be accepted
- Not suitable for wet rooms such as bathroom and sauna
- Please see installation instructions overleaf!

Easy Installation for Beautiful Room Setting!

Allow unopened cartons of planks to remain in the room where they are to be installed at least 72 hours prior to installation. (This is to allow the wood to adapt to the normal environment of the room.) All surfaces must be clean, dry, smooth and level before installation.

Do Not Install Planks Over:

1. Any floor exposed to excessively hot or cold temperature.
2. Any floor exposed to excessive moisture.
3. Radiant heated floors.
4. Particle boards.

Plank Installation:

1. Unroll Foam Underlayment to cover entire floor.
2. Begin in one corner of the room with four planks. The extended groove facing out into the room. The tongue pointing toward the starting wall.
3. At a slight angle insert the tongue of Plank A into the groove of Plank B, until the laminate edges meet, then press downward to lock. There should not be any gaps at the joints if attached correctly.
4. Follow this method in both directions until the floor is covered.
5. If last row needs to be cut then use a circular saw or any hand saw to cut as necessary.
6. Maintain a 1/4" (3mm) expansion space between the floor squares and the walls.

You will need to install a T-mold for Expansion after a run of 23' in width and 35' in length

Maintenance:

- Sweep, damp mop, or vacuum regularly
- Avoid abrasive cleaners
- Use furniture leg coaster
- Do not wax. This will make the floor's surface too slippery and may cause accidents.

TIMBERLAKE WARRANTY INFORMATION

30-YEAR WARRANTY

Manufacturer 30 year Limited Warranty. The manufacturer warrants to the original end consumer of laminate flooring panels for 30 years from the date of the purchase, that:

- The surface of the panels will not wear through.
- The panels will not fade from sunlight or normal artificial lighting.
- The panels will resist stains.
- The panels will resist water damage.
- The panel joints will remain secure after installation.
- The panels are free from manufacturing defects.

This limited warranty is made subject to the following conditions: Laminate flooring installation instructions, and must be used for indoor areas according to their utility rating.

- This limited warranty does not cover negligence, improper installation or maintenance, insufficient protection, improper alterations to the original materials, insects, severe accidents, and exposure to extreme heat, burns, fire, natural disasters such as hurricanes.
- The surface wear is readily visible, i.e. a minimum of one square inch, and is not the result of sand or other abrasive materials.
- The surface wear or damage is not the result of abuse, improper care and maintenance, sliding furniture or heavy objects across the floor without proper protection, severe impact, scratching, cutting, or chemical damage.
- This limited warranty applies to water damage from normal household spills when removed promptly. (See Routine Cleaning) This limited warranty specifically excludes water damage from standing water, urine or other corrosive liquids, excessive subsurface penetration or moisture emissions from concrete, leaking pipes or faucets, leaking appliances such as but not limited to washing machines, dishwashers, and refrigerators, hydrostatic pressure, flooding, natural disaster, such as hurricanes.
- Laminate flooring panels installed with any manufacturing defect are not covered by this limited warranty. Any such defective material will be replaced at no additional cost to the customer. Any damage that occurs during shipping is the responsibility of the shipping company.
- Any claim under this limited warranty shall be made by contacting your retailer within thirty (30) days after the defect is detected.
- Proof of purchase with the date of purchase must be presented with the claim.
- This limited warranty covers the repair or replacement, at the manufacturer option, of the affected laminate flooring panels. If repair is not commercially practicable, or if the design or model line that is claimed for is no longer available, the manufacturer will replace the affected materials with another design or model line of equal value.
- This limited warranty is not transferable, and extends only the original end consumer.
- The above constitutes the customer sole and exclusive remedy for claims under this limited warranty. This limited warranty constitutes the entire agreement between the parties.

LIFETIME STRUCTURAL WARRANTY

Gala Manufacturing offers a Lifetime Structural Warranty for residential use on Gala's Laminate flooring. This warranty covers all Gala laminate flooring properly installed in approved product applications as recommended by Gala Manufacturing.

Gala Manufacturing warrants Gala's laminate flooring, in its original manufactured state to be defect-free with regard to lamination, assembly, and milling.

DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTY

This limited warranty does not create for or impose upon the manufacturer any obligations or liabilities arising from any other warranties, express or implied, including merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. The manufacturer shall not be liable to the customer or any other person from any incidental, special, or consequential damages, and disclaims liability for breach of any other express or implied warranties with respect to this product. Some jurisdictions do not allow exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the foregoing exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages may not obtain. This limited warranty gives the customer specific legal rights. Such rights may vary from one jurisdiction to another.
